Directions to St. John's - and Meeting Notes

Directions:

Coming from the north on Highway 1

From Highway 1 going south - Exit 402A Casa Verde

Left on Casa Verde – stay on Casa Verde to the T intersection at Fairgrounds Road.

Turn right on Fairgrounds Road –stay on Fairgrounds .3 miles (over the overpass) – Fairgrounds Rd becomes Mark Thomas Dr.

Turn left at Josselyn Canyon Road and an immediate right into the St. John's Parking lot

Enter the Parish hall through the parking lot or Rose Garden entrance

Coming from the East on Rt 68

Going West on Rt 68

Take a right off Rt 68 at the Monterey Airport exit/Olmsted Road

Make the first Left onto Garden Road

Stay on Garden Road to the T intersection (traffic light) at Fairgrounds Rd

Make a left onto Fairgrounds (which becomes Mark Thomas Dr. after you go over the overpass

Go about .3 miles

Make a left at Josselyn Canyon Rd and an immediate right into the St. John's Parking lot

Enter the Parish Hall through the parking lot or Rose Garden entrance

Notes: We will have a continental style breakfast for you with juice, coffee, tea and various bagels and assorted pastries and fruit. Beverages will be available throughout the meeting.
